Consultation Period for proposed bills 2, 3 and 4 closes 25 November 2022.



- a. Replaces Home Building Act (HB Act)
- b. Licence required for:
 - all building work (resi and commercial) including physical and intellectual work
 - ii. other regulated work (eg fire safety, specialist work)
- c. Public register of licences to include track record
- d. Home building work:
 - clarifies 'developers' (same as RAB Act) liable for statutory warranties
 - i. statutory warranties extend to all home building work (incl under \$5K)
 - iii. new 'fit for habitation' test
 - v. formal requirements for residential contracts remain
 - v. replaces 'major defect' with 'serious defect' (extended to 10 years for serious defects, 3 years for other defects)
 - vi. new dispute resolution process through Fair Trading
 - vii. insurance requirement for resi stays for all 'major work' contracts (exemptions may apply)
 - viii. prescribes variation and payment processes (eg maximum payment amounts)
- e. Brings EP&A Act certification and subdivision into the building system new obligations on issue of OC
- f. Duty of care provisions from DBP clarified (all buildings, 10 years)
- g. Move Engineers Scheme from DBP to Building Bill to cover all building classes
- h. Interior designers and pre-purchase inspectors require licence

Building Compliance and Enforcement Bill (BCE Bill)

- a. Replaces RAB Act, covers all buildings
- b. Gives Dept enforcement powers across various other Acts see above
- c. BWRO on all buildings, Undertakings, Stop Work and general compliance notice
- d. Notice of completion and ability to withhold OC on all buildings
 - Building and Construction Legislation Amendment Bill (Amendment Bill)
- . Amends various other Acts
- b. Duties on supplychain
- c. Levies

- d. Duty on registered practitioners to ensure associates not phoenixing
- e. Changes to payment adjudication and retention trust money under SOP
- Environmental Planning and Assessment (Development Certification and Fire Safety) Amendment (Fire Safety) Regulation 2022 (New Fire Safety Regs)

Amends existing Regs and DBP

- Building and Other Fair Trading Legislation Amendment Bill 2022 (DLI and other amendments)
- a. Introduces decennial liability insurance
- b. DBP and RAB stop work orders and undertakings to be publicly available
- c. Increased penalties under RAB Act
- . Ability to rectify serious defects without EPA approval/consent under RAB Act
- e. Expands scope of BWROs
- f. Expanded information sharing
- . Misc. amendments to Explosives Act

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
